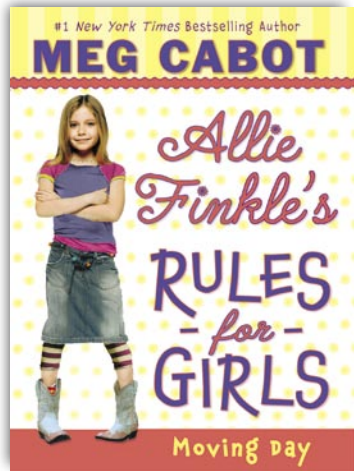

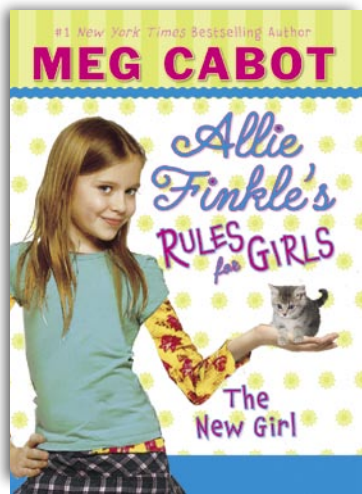
DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

You've read all three **Allie Finkle's Rules for Girls** books in the *New York Times* bestselling series. Now it's time to talk about them, and find out what your friends think!



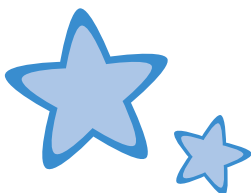
Book One: Moving Day

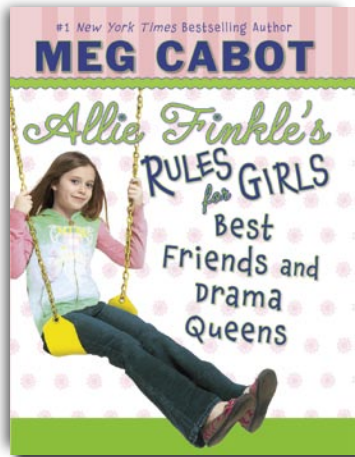
1. Allie Finkle likes rules. That's why she likes math and science so much, because "you know where you stand with them rulewise." Do you and Allie share some of the same rules?
